MINISTRY UPDATE

Philippines:

We have received the budget for the 2002 evangelistic series in the Philippines. To hold a series, buy land and build a church is fourteen thousand dollars. We intend to hold three series next year if the Lord opens the way. We will be working with Steve and Donna Dickie and their ministry, *Strawberry Meadows*, as we did this year. We expect them to raise most of the funding for their series. We are expecting the brethren from London to raise the finances for the series they will present. If the Lord convicts you to help support this ongoing work in the Philippines, please mark your offerings *Philippines 2002*. We will keep you informed of the plans as they further develop. It is very helpful if the funding arrives well before the meetings, which will take place in January, as we plan to have Bible workers in the target area 3 months prior to the meeting, and we will need to locate property to purchase as well.

The work we have done in the past has some ongoing needs as well. We have three churches that we have contributed to the construction that are still incomplete. We have a weekly radio broadcast, several requests for small jungle chapels, and we are supporting a Bible worker who is assigned to prepare and follow up the areas where we have and will work in the future. If you could help in these projects please mark your funds, *Philippine Work*. Our monthly budget for the Bible worker and radio broadcast is four hundred and fifty dollars, and the goal to finish the three churches is nine thousand five hundred dollars.

Ukraine:

A few years ago I met a evangelist from Canada at an ASI meeting in California. I shared my material with him and we began a friendship though email and telephone. His appreciation of the prophetic material is what generated an invitation to share at a camp meeting in Canada last year. He was also there and we further cemented our friendship and relationship.

After 33 years in pastoral work and evangelism Vic Gill is retiring in May. He will stay on in a contract capacity for another year, but he then intends to continue to do free-lance evangelism where the Lord opens the way. Though primarily doing his evangelistic work in Canada for the last 11 years, he has also held 16 crusades in the Ukraine. His most recent ended a little over a month ago. As the Lord supplies, *Future for America* intends to support Pastor Gill in his ongoing free-lance evangelistic work.

We have an evangelistic series of his material, which consists of 26 presentations, which we are offering for you to listen to. It will be a great blessing to your non-SDA friends and even SDA friends who need to go over the old time Advent message. I believe you will be blessed by his powerful messages. We are supplying these at a special price of forty dollars, which is twelve dollars off the regular price. (Remember our shipping and handling formula has increased to three dollars, plus fifteen percent.)

I asked pastor Gill to send a letter I could include in this newsletter. The following is the slightly edited letter:

Dear Brother Jeff, Enclosed you will find material along with various and sundry letters from my crusade in Dubno, Ukraine. This was my second series in Dubno.

Laws have changed since I was there last, (two and a half years ago). Now they have a law forbidding the use of public halls for the use of religious purposes. But, praise the Lord! God intervened and our brethren so arranged things to get the use of a music college auditorium for a month. We went 26 nights straight—no breaks.

Our little hall seated 340, but we managed to pack over 500 in there each evening. The entryway was also packed. We set up an additional 160 chairs in the entrance and we used a video system so that people there could see what was happening in the hall. The people who came were from all walks of life—teachers, doctors, nurses, ministers from other churches (mainly Baptist and Pentecostal), KGB officers, and the head of the mafia for that area. There were business people and also common people from all over that area.

We rented a bus to bring people from some of the neighboring villages. Many of them walked for miles because there wasn't room for them on the bus—or the bus wasn't coming to their village. Our own members were asked to stay home because there wasn't enough room. I would have been glad to run two sessions a night, but the hall was only

available for a short time as the college needed the hall until just a short time before the time to begin the meetings. We had 125 children in the children's meetings.

We had over 200 decisions for Christ in this crusade with 23 of them being baptized the last Sabbath of the series. There are about 50 plus that are in a baptismal class at present with most of the others, who have made their decisions. coming to church on Sabbath. There are a number of other people that are coming, interests from the interests that came to the meetings. And so the circle is widening.

This area is building a new church. They have the walls, roof, windows, etc. in. They didn't have any heat and I was able to raise enough money for the heating system before I went. They should now installing the heating system. The pastor went to Poland to pick up the furnace and all the fixings that he needed for the project. We are very thankful to the generous people who help support the work in the Ukraine.

There are many interesting experiences that I could tell you about, but time does not permit—except to say briefly, that the Lord blessed wonderfully. A young man who was on his deathbed was healed through the power of prayer. He had a ruptured appendix for a whole day before they discovered it. The doctors said there was no hope for him unless God intervened. He did. Praise the Lord! This young man was baptized three years before when I was there. He was released from the hospital and was able to attend the last meeting and came personally to thank me for our prayers in his behalf.

One night we had seven Orthodox priests who came to see what the meetings were all about (the night I preached on Daniel 7). Shortly after that they tried to shut us down. Our meetings were the talk of the town. People everywhere were saying in all the years no one ever had so many people coming to that hall every night for such a long period of time, as Victor Gill. All glory be to God.

We have also helped to build churches and to purchase home churches. There is one church that is desperate for help. This church is located in Vinnitsa in the Podolska Conference. They have the walls up (we brought money for that three or four years ago) but they haven't the money for the roof. Now the main structure needs a roof and windows to get it out of the weather. We had so many people who came to see us, begging for assistance. It is so hard to turn them down. But we can only do so much!

I hope this will give you a glimpse into what this crusade and our work is all about. I am looking forward to going back again as soon as I possibly can. I don't know when that will be, but the Lord can open a way.

I will be retiring the end of May this year. However I have committed myself to do another year of evangelism on a contract basis for the Maritime conference of which I am presently employed. That means another five crusades. I plan on moving out west the first of June and getting settled there somewhere close to our children and grandchildren. That will be home base from then on. We have no address there yet but will keep you posted as to our whereabouts as soon as we get settled.

We are praying that the Lord will help us find a place somewhere that we can afford without going into debt. I think that it is too late in earth's history to do that. That may be hard to do with only \$20,000, if that. That doesn't go very far nowadays. But with God all things are possible. He says, "Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and all these things shall be added unto you." I'm claiming that promise. But if we could get settled soon then possibly we could go again in August. We'll see, there's a lot of planning and preparation that has to go into getting one self and the team ready. Whenever I go, though, it will be to the city of Mariupol in the far east of Ukraine, almost to the Russian border, down by the coast of the Black Sea.

God bless you, dear brother. Keep up the good work! There's so much yet to be done. Truly the "Harvest is ripe but the laborers are few". Sincerely, your brother in Christ, Vic.

P.S. I was invited to preach in a Baptist Church. The minister came nearly every night to my meetings along with 50 of his members. The day I spoke at his church he told his members that if they felt a conviction to join with the Seventhday Adventist church that they had his blessing. He told me that he is convicted on the Sabbath truth, and on most everything else as well. He is continuing his studying.

We are seeking to raise eight thousand dollars for the upcoming series Pastor Gill will hold in Mariupol, Ukraine. If you can help please mark your funds, Ukraine Meeting. If you would like to help with the church just mentioned mark

your funds, *Ukraine Church*. I hope you can listen to his audio sermons, for you will see that his style is the old Advent message.

Dear Jeff and Kathy, I sincerely love these tapes and studies. They are blessing me greatly. Thank you so much for sharing with me what God has been blessing you with. Fingerprint May Soon Be Needed to Buy Groceries

The day will come when you put your finger on a scanning device to prove who you are before you engage in transactions at retail stores, ATMs, banks and even when you buy groceries. One company making such a device is engaged in a pilot project with the nation's largest grocery chain.

Biometric Access Corp. has teamed up with four *Kroger* stores in the Houston area to test a point-of-sale finger-scanning device for retail transactions. The pilot project has been under way for just over a year and is working well, even though some customers don't like it, according to *Kroger* spokesman Gary Huddleston.

The *Kroger* stores are using the device to provide positive identification for payroll check cashing, not for actual sales. Huddleston says customer acceptance is one of the challenges that must be overcome if the device is to be used for all transactions.

"Many customers have seen the value of the security in the system. The finger image is positive identification," Huddleston told *NewsMax.com* in a phone interview. He said a personal identification number was not very secure.

Will the finger-image scanner become common in all retail stores in the future?

"I'm sure it will," said Huddleston. "Customer acceptance is one challenge, and cost is the other challenge. As soon as we overcome those."

The finger-image scanner can easily be used for all point-of-sale transactions, including the use of checks, credit cards and debit cards, according to Biometric Access Corp. spokesman Hal Jennings. The system is also used for computer security and for clocking workers in and out of work, replacing old-fashioned time cards.

The use of finger-image scans is hailed by some and highly criticized by others.

"My primary objection is to government surveillance of citizens, more so than that of private businesses. However, the trend by retailers and employers to use biometrics to screen customers and employees is alarming," said activist Scott McDonald, who has a Web site (www.networkusa.org/fingerprint.shtml) that fights the use of fingerprints.

He says the use of finger-image scans by retail stores is one way the government can "condition" the public to "accept the same kind of perpetual scrutiny by government using the same technologies."

McDonald told NewsMax.com that he was concerned about an increase in the number of government and business partnerships.

"It is likely the information generated by private biometric scanning by banks, businesses and employers will eventually be linked to, or accessible by, government computers," explained McDonald.

Biometric Access Corp. has also established a contract with H.E. Butt Grocery Co. in Texas "which will result in a large-scale implementation of the SecureTouch On-Time(tm) time and attendance system," Jennings said.

More than 700 units will be installed in stores using biometric fingerprint readers to keep track of 50,000 employees as they clock in and out of work. Biometric Access Corp. also sold 6,000 similar readers to the state of New York for the Office of Mental Health to be used to protect highly confidential files. NewsMax.com.

Privacy: Smile! They're watching you.

Many visitors to Tampa last month may not have noticed the surveillance cameras at the Super Bowl or outside the bars, restaurants, and cinemas in the historic district. But the cameras noticed the visitors, scanning their faces and feeding the images to a computer. It electronically riffled through a database of digital mug shots, looking for a match. No arrests were made, but Tampa police say the facial recognition technology could be deployed "anywhere the public gathers." Software makers say it would also improve security for concerts, amusement parks, and schools. And one company, Visage Technology, says officials from the Salt Lake City Winter Olympics are considering its system.

Critics say the "faceprint" technology may constitute an illegal search. A further worry: Several states are building databases of digitized drivers' license photos, which could enable the system to track the public movements not only of criminals—but of nearly all adults. U.S. News & World Report, February 8, 2001.

Scalia slams "living document philosophy"

The Constitution is an enduring document but not a "living" one, and its meaning must be protected and not repeatedly altered to suit the whims of society, US Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia said in Milwaukee. Scalia, often reviled as an arch-conservative who would do the nation harm, admitted to a respectful crowd of more than 1,000 people at Marquette University that his "originalist" judicial philosophy is not popular.

In contrast, the idea of a "living Constitution" in which the meaning can be interpreted as society changes is "seductive," he said. He insisted that only his approach—interpreting the Constitution based on the Framers' precise words and the meaning they intended at the time—can preserve the Constitutions guiding principles. *Journal Staff Sentinel*.

Key to Liberty

"History has taught us that freedom cannot survive unless it is based on moral foundations," former British Prime Minister Maragaret Thatcher said in an speech in Fort Meyers, Florida, as quoted in the journal *Imprimis*. "You can get the economics right, but in addition liberty must be cultivated as a moral quality... I like very much what John Adams, your second president, wrote in 1798: 'Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.' That idea was right at the heart of your nations founding." *Spotlight*, May 7, 2001.

"How is it with our lawmakers, and the men in our courts of justice? If it was necessary that those who minister in holy office should have clear minds and full control of their reason, is it not also important that those who make and execute the laws of our great nation should have their faculties unclouded?" *Temperance*, 46.

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

Inattention, Apathy, and Liberty

The greatest threat to civil liberties is not from a single, dramatic event, such as a terrorist attack or computer blackout. Rather, the true danger lies in a popular loss of esteem for the civil and religious rights of minorities. Our constitutional order is endangered most by the inattention and apathy that allow the spirit of its liberties to fade away from the consciousness of the people, and then, by natural progression, from our civil institutions and courts of justice.

History shows that **the loss of personal liberties occurs over a period of time**. When a chronically indulgent, apathetic, and spiritually careless people are plunged into economic, social, or military distress, they will often allow their freedoms to be exchanged for a stronger economy and greater security. But the willingness to make this trade-off cannot happen overnight, especially in a democracy—it takes years of civic inattention. **The irony is that those predicting a sudden, spectacular loss of liberty** may well be distracted from the day-to-day work of preventing the slower degradation of those same liberties.

The increasing willingness of the majority to insist on the acceptance and practice of its religious traditions in the public sphere does not bode well for the fate of First Amendment freedoms in whatever "crisis" we first encounter in the new millennium. *Liberty*, January-February 2000.

Bush Aims to Strengthen Catholic Base

Since taking over the White House, President Bush and top advisers have been assiduously cultivating Catholic voters in an attempt to realign a once-Democratic constituency in much the same way that the Republican Party in the 1970s and 1980s won over southern evangelical Protestants.

A number of Republican operatives view the Catholic vote as the linchpin of a larger Republican strategy to gain solid majorities among all white religious voters—critical to Bush's reelection prospects.

"Religiously active voters have been gradually migrating to the Republican Party, leaving the Democrats as the party of the religiously indifferent as well as the politically liberal," pollster Steve Wagner, who is a member of an informal Catholic advisory group to the White House, recently wrote in the conservative Catholic magazine *Crisis*. "The migration began in the 1970s among morally conservative evangelical Protestants, especially in the South. Now, with Election 2000, it seems clear that religiously active Catholics are joining in, moving inexorably away from the solidly Democratic voting patterns that used to be a hallmark of American Catholics."

Bush, seeking to capitalize on those trends, has met privately with at least three high Catholic Church officials and has adopted Catholic themes in speeches; his staff has instituted a weekly conference call with an informal group of Catholic advisers; and the Republican National Committee is setting up a Catholic Task Force.

In the 2000 election, Bush made large gains among Catholic voters. According to *Voter News Service* (VNS) exit polls, Bush lost the Catholic vote to Al Gore by three percentage points, 50 to 47. In contrast, Bill Clinton's margin among Catholics was 16 percentage points in 1996 and nine points in 1992.

Wagner said those gains were largely the result of Bush's success among the 42 percent of Catholics who regularly attend Mass.

"Among religiously active Catholics, who have a discernible political identity in contrast to the nonreligiously active, Bush won by 55 percent to Gore's 24 percent," Wagner wrote, citing private polling by his firm, *QEV Analytics*, and *Penn Schoen & Berland Associates Inc.* "This was the best Catholic showing for a Republican presidential candidate since 1972, equal to Ronald Reagan's 1984 showing and better than his 1980 showing."

Wagner's findings are supported by broader trends: The more religious a voter is—based on church attendance—the more likely the voter is to be a Republican. At the two extremes, voters who attend services more than once a week voted for Bush by 63 percent to 36 percent, said VNS, while those who never attend services voted for Gore, 61 percent to 32 percent.


Bush, bidding to improve on those margins in 2004, has met with Archbishop Justin Rigali of St. Louis, Bishop Donald Wuerl of Pittsburgh and Washington's Cardinal Theodore McCarrick. His staff has created an informal advisory group that includes Crisis publisher Deal Hudson and Princeton University political scientist Robert George.

Perhaps most important, Bush has incorporated language familiar to Catholics—what strategists call Catholic

"buzzwords"—into speeches. In a March 22 address for a new Catholic University center honoring Pope John Paul II, Bush told a gathering that included Detroit Archbishop Adam Cardinal Maida and McCarrick:

"The culture of life is a welcoming culture, never excluding, never dividing, never despairing, and always affirming the goodness of life in all its seasons. In the culture of life we must make room for the stranger. We must comfort the sick. We must care for the aged. We must welcome the immigrant. We must teach our children to be gentle with one another. We must defend in love the innocent child waiting to be born."

The effort to recruit Catholic voters has led to a striking change in the political climate in Washington. George noted in an interview last week that "in 1960, John



Kennedy went from Washington down to Texas to assure Protestant preachers that he would not obey the pope. In 2001, George Bush came from Texas up to Washington to assure a group of Catholic bishops that he would."

Republican advocacy of "compassionate conservatism" meshes well with Catholic doctrine, in contrast to more hard-edged Republican themes of free-market conservatism and the libertarianism promoted by groups such as the Cato Institute, Hudson and George both argue.

"It's almost too good to be true, how much they have come to understand what appeals to religiously active Catholics," Hudson said. "We have a leader who is not afraid of sharing his vision of a country that welcomes life, protects it by law, but does it in a way that is not moralistic or self-righteous."

Republican appeals to Catholics are in many ways more complex than appeals to Protestant evangelical voters because Catholics are less hostile to government and many believe in the obligation of the state to relieve poverty, George maintains.

What George describes as a Catholic "third way" dates to the Encyclical letter "on the condition of the working classes" issued by Pope Leo XIII in 1891, and has been evident throughout the 20th century. George cites John Paul II's 1991 Encyclical as an example:

"The obligation to earn one's bread by the sweat of one's brow also presumes the right to do so. A society in which this right is systematically denied, in which economic policies do not allow workers to reach satisfactory levels of employment, cannot be justified from an ethical point of view, nor can that society attain social peace... Love for others, and in the first place love for the poor, in whom the church sees Christ himself, is made concrete in the promotion of justice."

Opposition to abortion is crucial in appeals to religiously active Catholics but inadequate on its own, Hudson and George agree.

"Pro-life won't seal the deal," George said. "People have to think the Republican Party is not just the party of the rich and the exploitative."

Bush's ability to seal the deal with moderate Catholic voters will be determined in 2004, but in the interim, he has strengthened his base of support among conservative Catholics, including Paul Weyrich, head of the Free Congress Foundation.

Weyrich wrote that he recently asked senior Bush adviser Karl Rove to tell the president "that he has mastered the art of Catholic governance." Rove, according to Weyrich, replied, "That's pretty good for a Methodist." Thomas B. Edsall, Washington Post.

Solution Observe Sunday, Save the Environment

Trieste, Italy—There may be a solution to global warming after all: Keep holy the Lord's day. Following last weekend's session of the G8 Environment Ministers, held in Trieste, Italy, a writer for the Italian newspaper Avvenire ventured a suggestion. "The eight Ministers of the Environment seemed to have come to an agreement in Trieste to play a different tune in our planet, threatened by miasmas and poisons resulting from unbridled consumerism," Vittorio Morero writes.

On Sunday, the eight renewed their commitment to struggle against global warming and promised to try to reach an agreement to reduce gas emissions that influence the warming. Avvenire's proposal, an alternative to rampant consumerism, is to continue to keep Sunday as a day dedicated to cleaning up the environment, to rest, and, in the case of Christians, to Sunday Mass.

The newspaper applauds, for instance, the initiative to have "no cars on Sundays," which several European cities are observing in their historical centers. Adults and children take to the streets on this day, using non-polluting public transport. Avvenire suggests that outdoor cultural events be offered in the summer. "As Christians, it is natural that we should try to understand the urgent invitation in Novo Millennio Ineunte to the Christian community to go out to sea, after having been refreshed by Sunday worship, the Word of God, and participating joyfully in the liturgy," Morero writes.

"If John Paul II offers Sunday as the program for renewal it is because it is well known that also, in the area of Christian tradition, Sunday has been and continues to be ruined by the passive acceptance of consumer models that lack quality," Morero continues. "Needless to say, it is not enough just to bet on Sunday, but on a Sunday that is rich in content and very attractive. The stadiums will have to be closed and museums, libraries and theaters (theaters that do not disdain the classical) opened; brief tourist trips organized to nearby places, so that we are not ignorant of the beauties surrounding us."

"We will have to abandon the logic of the market and for at least one day entrust ourselves to our imagination; to our own, and not one imposed by the priests and acolytes of the global empire. . . . Pastors of souls must think about it, who have received . . . the Lord's commandment: 'Remember to keep holy the sabbath day.'"

The article concludes: "Let us save Sunday, the place and time of our civilization." Zenit.org.

The Sublimest Theme

"God forbid that I should glory, save in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by whom the world is crucified unto me, and I unto the world." Galatians 6:14.

On Calvary, the universe witnessed Satan at his worst and God at His best. It was the climax of the great controversy between Christ and Satan. The devil vented all his venom on the Son of God, who bore it out of love for you and me. The only begotten Son of God, who had ever been in the bosom of the Father, was for the first time forsaken by Him. Christ endured the mysterious agony of separation from His Father. It is beyond our comprehension, that in Gethsemane and on Calvary, Christ tasted the sufferings of death for every man.

God has no fellowship with sin, so for the first time since eternity, He turned away from His Son, who was made sin for us on Calvary, and this supreme anguish broke the heart of Jesus, who cried, "My Father, My Father, why hast Thou forsaken Me?" This sublimest of all themes, is unfathomable mystery which will be contemplated by the saints through eternity. What the world was as just another Roman execution, was actually the most beautiful picture of God's love, as well as the ugliest scene of Satanic hatred witnessed by the universe.

Don't dismiss it as something you've heard before. Rather, see it as a profound truth that will fill the minds of the saved through all eternity. We must start now to cherish this truth, stand in awe of its sublimity.

The Chinese say that every man needs three "knows"—to know words, to know things, and to know people. We add three more: We must (1) know ourselves, (2) know the world, and (3) know God.

First to know ourselves. We were made in the image of God, but Satan has robbed us of that image. We are now born with a human nature and an animal nature. We lack a divine nature, which the Holy Spirit wants to give us through the new birth. For Jesus taught that we must be born again of the Holy Spirit. Thus the union of the divine and human nature in Jesus—the Word made flesh—can take place in us, as our flesh is made the Word, when we are born again of the Holy Spirit and feed daily on the word of God, the bread of life.

We should prize this privilege that is ours—to obtain the divine nature that God offers us. 2 Peter 1:4 says, "by which we have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."

So we come to know the world, and learn to escape the corruption that is in it through lust. Of His disciples Jesus prayed, "I have given them Thy word, and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world... Sanctify them through Thy truth, Thy word is truth." John 17:14, 17. When we know ourselves, and know that the world is corrupt through lust, we will keep the truth that Christ has given to sanctify us. The cross of Christ, which is the central theme of the Bible, crucifies us to the world, and the world to us. It tells us that the present world, which rejected Christ, will soon be consumed in a lake of fire.

As we fill our thoughts with the word of God, we come to know Him. Jesus prayed, "This is life eternal,

that they might know Thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, who Thou hast sent." John 17:3.

Ellen White said, "The cross of Christ will be the science and the song of the redeemed through all eternity. In Christ glorified they will behold Christ crucified. Never will it be forgotten that He whose power created and upheld the unnumbered worlds through the vast realms of space . . . humbled Himself to uplift fallen man; that He bore the guilt and shame of sin, and the hiding of His Father's face, till the woes of a lost world broke His heart and crushed out His life on Calvary's cross. . . As the nations of the saved look upon their Redeemer and behold the eternal glory of the Father shining in His countenance . . . they break forth in rapturous songs: 'Worthy, worthy is the Lamb that was slain, and hath redeemed us by His own most precious blood!" *The Great Controversy*, 651.

Since the cross of Christ will be the science and the song of the redeemed through all eternity, and if we plan to be among the redeemed, should we not be eager even now to study the cross of Christ and tell others about it and how we love this truth? If we give it only passing thought today, how can it be our science and our song in the future? If worldly things occupy our minds today, we will soon be conformed to the world, and become strangers to the cross of Christ, let alone make it our science and our song.

We use our heads to study the science of salvation; and our hearts to sing of its wonders. These activities develop our higher nature, thus sanctifying the human and animal natures in us. This must be our daily exercise.

We need to face this honestly and take a serious look at ourselves. Are we ready now to take part in the science and the song of the redeemed? If not, why not? Why our lack of interest? Is it because the world is holding our attention? If so, we are in danger, must wake up, and see the value of this sublimest theme.

There is a teaching that says that when Christ returns, he will give us a new body, and we will all become holy and stop sinning. People like to hear it—that Christ guarantees us a place in heaven, so we need not resist temptation. "Take it easy," the devil says, "you can't help sinning anyway. When Christ returns, He will give you a new body that cannot sin." So we feel relieved—free to live as we please. That is exactly what the devil wants. He wants you to live as you please and not think of the future. So when the end comes, you will be with him in the lake of fire. Such a false gospel is pleasing to the unconverted

heart. Don't be fooled by it.

The Bible says, "Our citizenship is in heaven, from which we also eagerly wait for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body, according to the working by which He is able even to subdue all things to Himself." Philipians 3:20-21. John says in 1 John 3:2-3, "We know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. And everyone who has this hope in him, purifies himself, just as He is pure."

Here are two words: "subdue" and "purify." Who does the subduing? Christ subdues all things to Himself. Who does the purifying? "Everyone who has this hope in him, purifies himself, just as He is pure." Note that the subduing and purifying take place before our bodies are transformed. In other words, if Christ does not subdue you, and you don't purify yourself just as He is pure, your body will not be transformed like His glorious body.

In the King James Bible the English word "character" does not appear. But the Greek word charakter occurs once in Hebrews 1:3, it is translated "express image." The text reads, "Who being the brightness of His glory and the express image of His person, and upholding all things by the word of His power. The English word "character" comes from it, and retains its essence. The body is a material, visible thing. The character is not visible, but it determines the destiny of the body. If we have the character of Christ, we have His express image. Only then will we qualify to receive a body like His. So the secret is to build a Christ-like character.

"Purify himself just as He is pure," is challenging. How can we purify ourselves? Well, that is what the Bible says. We must do the purifying, but the means of purification is provided by Christ—He has shed His blood for that purpose. We are to wash our robes in the blood of the Lamb. In actual practice, how is that done? It is to follow Jesus by faith as He applies His blood for us in the sanctuary. His words have a cleansing effect on our minds. Psalm 119:11 says, "Thy word have I hid in my heart, that I might not sin against Thee." Jesus says, "You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you." John 15:3. Ephesians 5:26 says that Christ is cleansing His church "with the washing of water by the word." Our part is to wash our minds with His word.

God works on the plan of cooperation—cooperation between God and man. He does His part, and we do ours. God's part is humanly impossible; our part is possible. Christ often used nature to teach the truth. He talked

of sowing and reaping. We will do the same: man plows, sows and reaps. God gives sunshine and rain. Thus man cooperates with God. We can't sit back and say, Christ has died for me, and there's nothing I can do to merit God's favor. Have you heard that before? It makes you relax and be and easy victim of temptation. Christ says, "Watch and pray, lest ye enter into temptation." The devil wants you to quit praying and fall asleep.

So we concentrate on our sublimest theme. Jesus said, "As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifter up." God did the humanly impossible thing of giving His Son to die on the cross. Ours is the task of gazing at and lifting up the crucified One for all who are bitten by sin to look and live.

The cross of Christ will be the science and the song of the redeemed through all eternity. Never will it be forgotten that He whose power created and upheld the unnumbered worlds through the vast realms of space, humbled Himself to uplift fallen man. As the nations of the saved look upon their Redeemer and behold the eternal glory of the Father shining in His countenance they break forth in rapturous song: "Worthy, worthy is the Lamb that was slain, and hath redeemed us by His own most precious blood.!"

Revelation 5:9 calls it a new song. Rev. 14:3 again says, "they sung a new song before the throne." When will it be an old song? Never! For this theme will never grow stale, but will always be new. Their spiritual sensibilities will be heightened with passing time, and they will ever be awed by new light shining brighter and brighter from the cross of Christ.

Quake Deaths Up for 2001

April 16, 2001—The largest number of fatalities so far this year occurred in January, when both India and El Salvador were struck by deadly quakes. Between 30,000 and 40,000 people are estimated to have died in those two temblors. In February, when El Salvador was hit by a second temblor, another 315 people were killed.

Meanwhile, the same number of "significant" quakes—defined by USGS as measuring magnitude-6.5 or larger on the Richter scale, or causing fatalities, injuries or substantial damages—occurred in January 2000 and January 2001. In both months six significant earthquakes struck, but last year only seven deaths occurred from temblors during January.

One of this year's largest quakes occurred in the United States, when a magnitude 6.8 temblor rocked the Seattle and Olympia areas of Washington state on February 28. Fortunately, no deaths were attributed to the earthquake, and damages were miniscule compared to what they could have been in other, less prepared, cities of the world, USGS geologists said.

Last year, only about 225 people worldwide died in earthquakes, whereas fatalities topped 19,000 in 1999, when major quakes occurred in Turkey and Taiwan. The deadliest year of the 20th century was in 1976 when at least 225,000 people—and perhaps more than 600,000—were killed in a single quake that jolted Tianjin, China (formerly Tangshan).

The highest quake fatality rate this year occurred in India, where at least 30,000 people—and perhaps 50,000—died from a 7.7-magnitude earthquake on January 26. The death toll from the magnitude-7.6 January 13 quake and its aftershocks in El Salvador, is 1,170. Many of the deaths occurred when quake-triggered landslides crushed homes.

The USGS estimates that several million earthquakes occur around the globe each year. Many go undetected because they hit remote areas or have such small magnitudes that they aren't felt. USGS records 50 earthquakes each day, or about 20,000 per year. California, which averages 20 quakes per day, has the most frequent seismic activity in the United States. *DisasterRelief.org*.

More Flooding in the Midwest

The Mississippi River crested Monday (April 30) for the second time in the last two weeks in the upper Great Plains. Residents, who had hoped the worst flooding was over, began stacking sandbags again. The river Monday reached 23.6 feet in St. Paul, Minnesota—9.6 feet above flood stage and the third-highest crest ever recorded there. Flood warnings were posted in Minnesota for the Minnesota, Mississippi and St. Croix rivers. In Illinois, the flooded Mississippi was slowly starting to recede, but the Army Corps of Engineers said it would not drop below flood stage in some places for several weeks. *DisasterRelief.org*.

Poison Kills More Than 60 Animals in Colorado

April 9,—A poison so deadly that it is banned in all but four states has killed 35 birds and 30 dogs and cats in a small Orchard Mesa, Colorado, neighborhood, police say. The poison even sickened a police officer who handled a stricken dog. The poisonings started in December, when a few dead starlings were found. Then dogs and cats began to die, some because of poisoned meat thrown into yards.

Police disclosed Thursday that veterinary experts at Texas A&M University have identified the poison as odium monofluoroacetate, widely known as Compound 1080. The compound was widely used in the West for predator control until it was banned in 1972. The poison was so toxic that it didn't stop with the predator but continued into the food chain, killing birds, coyotes, eagles, bears and others that came in contact with the targeted animal. It takes a very small amount to kill an animal or human. *DisasterRelief.org*.

2 Outbreak of Boils

April 27, California—A contaminated pedicurist's footbath led to unsightly and potentially disfiguring boils on 109 customers' legs ranging in size from a nickel to a half-dollar. The infections can be treated slowly with antibiotics, but can be painful and unsightly, and may leave scarring. Most people infected in the California outbreak had multiple sores or boils. One woman had 37 boils. State and federal health investigators believe a germ known as Mycobacterium fortuitum contaminated a footbath at a salon in Watsonville, California., and caused boils and lesions on the legs of as many as 108 women and one man last fall. Health officials also are investigating the case of a woman who may have been infected by another footbath in the San Diego area. DisasterRelief.org.

Mexican Volcano Erupts

The Popocatepetl volcano experienced a moderate eruption Sunday (April 29). The volcano, located about 40 miles south of Mexico City, has been closely monitored since December 18. when the volcano staged its most violent eruption in 1,200 years, spewing red-hot rock and forcing villagers near its base to evacuate for several weeks. DisasterRelief.org.

Bolivia Flooding

Heavy rains began falling in December and have continued during the normally dry Altiplano region of Bolivia. Throughout the country, more than 214,000 people have been affected by the subsequent flooding. Adventist News Network, April 18, 2001.

Rains Inundate Ecuador

April 4, 2001 QUITO—At least 40 people have died and thousands have been affected by the heavy rains that have battered Ecuador for the past three months. The coastal province of Manabi has been one of the hardest hit. Half of the fatalities have been reported there and extensive farmland has been flooded—losses range in the millions of dollars. The rain has damaged 42,000 acres of crops along the coast, with losses estimated at \$2 million. The Institute of Meteorology and Hydrology believes the rains will continue through April. DisasterRelief.org.

Extreme Cold Kills in Mongolia

Mongolia's coldest winter in living memory is unlike earthquake, flood and fire, yet it just as deadly, explains Llewellyn Juby, Country Director for ADRA Mongolia. Many mountain passes were closed all winter, cutting off supplies to parts of the country. The impact of severe temperatures was magnified by the two preceding summers that were the driest in 60 years. Last winter 2.3 million animals died, but this figure is predicted to double before the animals are out of danger when the grass turns green again. It has been correctly called the slow creeping death. Adventist News Network, April 18, 2001.

2 Violent Sandstorms hit China

Ferocious sandstorms have swept China's Inner Mongolia Autonomous Region since last Friday, reducing visibility in parts of northern Inner Mongolia and northeastern Jilin and Heilongjiang provinces to less than 160 feet. The sandstorm has affected most of northern China, including Beijing. DisasterRelief.org.

Northern France Inundated by Floodwaters

April 8, France—Floodwaters have inundated more than 50 districts in northern France forcing families to evacuate nearly 300 homes and leaving others without electricity. Up to 1,200 houses were flooded by the rise of the Somme River, with 280 homes evacuated. Flooding that started Friday after severe rains has been aggravated by high tides caused by the vernal equinox which ends Tuesday. DisasterRelief.org.

Epidemic in West Timor

The Jesuit Refugee Service Catholic aid group says dozens of East Timorese refugees are dying from a rapidly spreading diarrhoea epidemic in camps in Indonesian-ruled West Timor. Malnutrition is also claiming lives, and it says there have been no rice supplies to the camps since January. All foreign aid workers fled West Timor after three UN refugee workers were killed in their office in the border town of Atambua by an pro-Jakarta militia mob in September. DisasterRelief.org.

2 Powerful Storm Batters Bangladesh

At least 21 people were killed and more than 100 were injured in a series of storms that lashed parts of Bangladesh over the weekend, officials said on Monday (April 30). DisasterRelief.org.

Diarrhea Outbreak

Dhaka—For the past four weeks at least 100 people have died from diarrhea in Bangladesh and more are expected to fall victim in an annual disease outbreak. According to medics, 60 percent of the patients are children aged five or younger.

E coli bacteria is primarily responsible for the deaths. The bacteria is known to propagate at this time of the year as a result of several factors, including higher temperatures. Quick treatment to stop dehydration is the best medicine. The disease has left Bangladeshi hospitals struggling to cope with an influx of seriously ill patients. *DisasterRelief.org*.

Afghanistan Rabies

KABUL, April 9—Afghan health authorities said on Monday there had been a rise in cases of rabies in the capital Kabul but there was an acute shortage of vaccines. At least 80 people became victims of attacking dogs in March alone, about 50 percent more than in the previous month, they said. Residents said most of the victims were lying in hospital death beds because of lack of vaccines and that treatment overseas was beyond their reach. At least 35 people were attacked by rabid dogs in one single district of the city. Most victims are children, health officials said. *DisasterRelief.org*.

Locusts Threaten Drought-Hit Afghanistan

KABUL, **April 10**—Millions of locusts are threatening a vast area of northern Afghanistan and urgent aid is needed to prevent them spreading to neighboring countries. Sahibdad Pakbeen, a senior official with the agriculture ministry, said millions of locust larvae were scattered over seven provinces, the major fruit and cereal-producing region of the drought-hit country.

He said the ruling Taliban had asked the UN Food and Agriculture Organization to help it tackle the problem, which has added to the woes of a country battered by over 20 years of conflict and a harsh drought for the past two years. "There is no doubt the drought has forced the locusts to move from mountains and deserts to converge on agricultural sites. They have not yet been able to fly and when they do so this will be a global calamity," he told reporters. . DisasterRelief.org.

Afghanistan Refugee Crisis Worsens

On Monday (April 30), the UN High Commissioner for Refugees Ruud Lubbers urged a halt to fighting in Afghanistan for at least six months so that desperate refugees can return to their homes. Tens of thousands of Afghans have fled war and drought in their homeland only to be turned away by neighboring nations.

Lubbers' plea came while visiting Maslakh Camp, packed with 100,000 displaced Afghans and the largest of six UN-sponsored camps in the western Herat region. Nearly 2,000 people arrive at the camp daily, most from Badghis and Ghor provinces, where some farmers said it hasn't rained in more than a year. *DisasterRelief.org*.

Iran Drought

Tehran, April 29—The nation is facing a third consecutive year severe drought as water levels at dams and reservoirs continue to fall. A UN fact-finding team reported from Iran last July that the nation was on the verge of a full-fledged disaster, as the Islamic Republic accepted international aid for only the second time since 1979-Islamic Revolution. Hundreds of thousands of livestock died as Iran was struck by a second straight year of drought, and millions of people are thought to have been displaced. It is estimated that only three of Iran's 28 provinces had enough drinking water. *DisasterRelief.org*.

Millions in Africa Face Food Shortage

Kenya April 9,—An estimated 28 million people in Africa south of the Sahara face food shortages this year, according to a UN agency report released Monday. More than 60 percent of those facing food shortages—about 18 million people—live in eastern Africa, said the report, Food Supply Situation and Crop Prospects in Sub-Saharan Africa. Kenyan Woman Dies

NAIROBI, Kenya—Kenyan medical officials were investigating the death of a woman from suspected hemorrhagic fever on Monday, saying it was too early to determine whether she had contracted the deadly Ebola virus. A 24year-old police trainee died in Nyeri in central Kenya in early April after "bleeding from body openings and vomiting blood," according to a statement from Kenya's public health minister, Sam Ongeri. She fell ill with a high fever on March 31 and died just two days later at Mathari Mission Hospital in Nyeri, which lies 60 miles north of the Kenyan capital Nairobi. The statement did not mention the possibility of an outbreak of Ebola, a disease that struck neighboring Uganda in September, killing more than 170 people. *DisasterRelief.org*.

Epidemic Kills 200 Children

April 9, Nigeria—An epidemic of meningitis and measles has swept through the northern Nigerian city of Kano, killing at least 200 children. International aid workers said Nigerian authorities had declared Kano, the biggest city in the north, an epidemic zone but there was no official confirmation of this. A doctor at the Aishatu Bayero Children's Clinic in Kano said 200 children had died in the past two weeks of measles and cerebrospinal meningitis.
